Wall panel profiles

To finish off edges or to join panels in a corner, the appropriate profiles must be used. Use the table to help you select the right profiles for your design.

Vertical profiles are available in 2.45m and 2.75m long aluminium with 11.5mm depth excluding the Base profiles. The Base profile is aluminium, while the wall to floor, and bath/shower tray seal kits are white PVC.

End caps







Our Hydrolock[®] tongue and groove joining system creates a discreet, watertight joint without the need for grout. This means that our panels can be installed up to 5x faster than tiles.


When providing social housing, a speedy construction or refurbishment is crucial, but this often means a limited availability of designs. With Grant Westfield, you have a wide range of designs, colours and textures. Create the luxurious bathrooms of your tenants' dreams – for a fraction of the cost.

Easy Maintenance

One of the major challenges in the social housing sector is that bathrooms need to be refreshed for incoming tenants. This results in significant cleaning demands and, in many cases, the replacement of grout lines and in worse cases the wall tiles, before the new tenant moves in. With the use of our bathroom wall panels, downtime and cleaning costs can be dramatically reduced as Grant Westfield wall panels are grout-free and require only a simple wipe down with a non-abrasive detergent to maintain their pristine condition.

Increased Speed of Construction

Grant Westfield shower wall panels can be fitted in 1 day compared with 3–5 days for traditional tiles. There is no need to wait for specialist wet trades as our products can be fitted straight onto timber frameworks or plasterboard. Thanks to our precisely engineered Hydrolock[®] joint system, panels can simply be clicked into place—saving time and costs in the process.

Grant Westfield wall panels can also be supplied on a just-in-time basis to suit new build programmes.

Grant Westfield wall panels are approved to the wet room standard EAD 030437-00-0503, "Watertight covering kits based on inherently watertight boards for wet room floors and or walls", this means when using Multipanel or Naturepanel, walls do not have to be tanked in order to comply with NHBC building regulations clause 9.2.5.

Yorkshire Wildlife Park - Tailored Animal House

Yorkshire Wildlife Park, which was built on a former riding school and small farm attraction, has come a long way since it first opened in April 2009. The park is now a thriving conservation and welfare institution, home to some of the world's most endangered animals.

David Milburn, Head of Construction at Yorkshire Wildlife Park, speaks about the project:

"Since this was the first animal house of its kind built using second-hand containers with high thermal values, it was crucial to get everything right to prevent overheating in the summer and maintain a temperature of 22°C in the winter. The park needed a high-quality, durable wall panel that could be securely fixed to 12.5mm plywood. After evaluating various options, Multipanel was the ideal solution. Its tongue-and-groove connection provided the strength and resilience required to house a cheetah. Any exposed joints or raised edges could be easily damaged, but Multipanel's flush-fit prevented the cheetahs from causing harm."

Now, 15 months on, the Cheetah House has stood the test of time, with no defects despite initial concerns about lipping and durability. Yorkshire Wildlife Park (YWP) is committed to using this system for future refurbishments and new enclosures.

Multipanel is an easy-to-install system that also simplifies cleaning - an essential factor given that cheetahs tend to favour certain areas more than others, requiring extra attention when washing down.

"Although our previous supplier was practical, we sought a new product that maintained the same durability while offering a less clinical appearance.
